Do you accept my insurance plan?

Why do I have co-payments and deductibles?

Your copays and deductibles are part of your contract with your insurance carrier. Due to government regulations and contractual obligations with your insurance plan, we are required to collect co-payments and deductibles. What is co-insurance and how is that different from my deductibles and co-payments?

Coinsurance is a portion of the medical cost you pay after your deductible has been met, and your health plan pays its portion. Coinsurance is a way of saying that you and your insurance carrier each pay a share of eligible costs. Your PRC will help you understand your total out-of-pocket responsibility.
